# Owner Responsibilities

Ensure that such animal is not running at large

Ensure that dog does not enter School ground, playground, sports field, golf course, cemetery or any other areas where dogs are prohibited by posted signs.

If yard is unfenced, the dog must be kept a minimum of three (3) meters from the public sidewalk, roadway or property line.

It is the owner's responsibility if their dog defecates or causes damage to public or private property.

Make sure dog does not bite, bark, chase or cause physical harm to animals, bicycles, automobiles or human beings.



## *Dogs and Barking*

Barking is instinctive to the canine species. They bark to communicate with other dogs, to alert their owners of possible danger, to protect their property and sometimes out of boredom.

Responsible dog owners ensure their barking dogs do NOT disturb surrounding neighbors. Dogs should receive adequate exercise for stimulation to prevent boredom barking.

Please contact 306-753-2256 to report excessive barking disturbances.



## Licensing Fees

## Commonly asked questions:

Q: If I no longer own the dog, what should I do?

A: Contact the Town Office 753-2256, and your record will be amended.

Q: What if I have lost the dog license?

A: Call the above mentioned number or go to the Town Office and a new license will be issued for a \$5.00 fee.

Q: Can the license be transferred?

A: No, a license under this bylaw shall not be transferable from one dog to another.

Q: My dog is a working dog for a sight or hearing impaired person. Do I need to purchase a license?

A: Not in this instance. However, there is a form to complete that the Town of Macklin will keep on file. You will be issued a dog license free of charge.

Q: How long is my license in effect?

A: January 1 to December 31 of the calendar year.

Q: What if I move?

A: The dog must still be licensed while it resides in the Town of Macklin. Once you have reached your new home, please call the Town Office 753-2256 and cancel the old license.
