




## U17 MACKLIN LAKERS—GIRLS PROVINCIAL SOFTBALL CHAMPIONS

Being the hometown team at your hometown provincials doesn't happen too often, so the U17 Macklin Lakers took full advantage to make it the best it could be. The community members from Macklin & surrounding area, as well as the families from the Lakers team went above and beyond to make this weekend possible. From the organizers to the booth workers, the gate workers to the grounds crew, the table workers to the set up/clean up crew, the officials to the distinguished guests at the opening ceremonies, and everyone in between, they thank you from the bottom of their hearts for making this 2024 U17 C Girls Softball Provincials the successful one it was!

This weekend was one about perseverance, work ethic, and most importantly, teamwork. This team of 12 girls (6 veterans and 6 returning), as well as 3 coaches and the best manager around, came together with one goal in mind - a provincial championship! Winning in front of a hometown crowd would make it all the more special. Macklin has hosted provincials in the past, but the U17 Female division has never had the privilege of being the host age category. With a 6 team round robin draw, the Lakers found themselves coming up first against the Rosetown Angels, where they found their stride and came out on top, 12-5. Game two against the Northeast River Dogs was a 14-2 final in the Lakers favour. The Saturday morning game versus the Kindersley Royals proved to be their most challenging of the round robin, and the girls were handed their first loss of the tournament, 20-13, but the girls battled back and came into game 4 with renewed determination and bested the Moosomin Predators, 8-0, clinching 2nd place overall. This finish put the girls into the Final Four, with a 2nd versus 3rd semi final match-up against Rosetown. The girls had an unreal, almost text-book game against the Angels, and

won the semi-final, 10-0! With that win, the girls were now going for gold against the Northeast River Dogs. In the game, the Lakers pulled out to an early lead, but in familiar fashion, they like to keep things interesting for their spectators, so at the start of the 7th inning, they were all tied up, 8-8. After some successful batting from Macklin in the 7th inning, the girls pulled ahead by 5! With last bat in the inning, the River Dogs mustered up all they had, but the Lakers had gold in their sights and weren't going to back down. When the dust cleared and the final pitch was thrown, with a final score of 13-8, the Macklin Lakers were this year's U17 C Girls Provincial Softball Champions. ❤️🏆❤️

They played a number of exhibition games with surrounding communities and finished the year participating in the Softball Saskatchewan Festival tournament in Kindersley.

The U7 Girls had a great year of learning and growing as a team. Congratulations on all the improvements seen this season.



The **U11U boys** team for the 2024 season consisted of 14 players for the regular season and 11 for provincials. The regular season team had many successes including winning their home tournament in June. The provincial team travelled to Melville to compete in Tier 4 provincials in July. The team went undefeated in the round robin in their pool. This led them to the semi final game against Shellbrook. It was a battle that ended up in an extra inning with Macklin coming out as the winner. The final game saw us play Nipawin. The U11U team finished second and won the silver medal.

### U11 Softball Season

This year, 22 girls aged 9-10 registered for U11 softball, allowing MMBA to form two teams for the first time in years. Splitting the teams and managing them was challenging but rewarding. Derrick Lantz coached one team, while I, along with Justin Reschny and Marlie Wagner, coached the other. The two teams faced off throughout the season, providing exciting games and opportunities to evaluate players for the provincial roster. My team, Volk, played 11 games, finishing with 8 wins and 3 losses against skilled opponents. In the U11B North Provincial tournament in Meadow Lake (July 5-7) with 23 teams competing to win the championship. Macklin Lakers competed in a tough pool with the 2 best teams in their pool. We ended the round robin with 2 wins and 2 losses, placing 3rd in our pool. It was a pleasure coaching this talented group, and I look forward to seeing their future successes.


